Brazilian National Council of State Funding Agencies

- **Brazil in H2020: the non-automatic funding rule**
 - Emerging Economies no longer eligible to receive automatic funding under H2020

- **How can Brazil participate in this framework?**
 - Coordinated Calls – i.e. – in Biofuels and ICT
 - Structuring co-financing mechanisms to cover the costs of Brazilian participants within international consortia together with the EU



Role of CONFAP & of the Brazilian State Research Foundations

- December 2014 CONFAP and the Delegation of the EU in Brazil sign a “Letter of Intent” to promote Brazilian participation within Horizon 2020
- Almost all State Funding Agencies (FAPs) in Brazil which are part of CONFAP have signed the Accession to the Letter of Intent
- CONFAP is assisting its FAPs for fine-tuning, finalizing and launching their own “Guidelines” which define the implementation of the Letter of Intent



➤ What are the Guidelines?

- The Guidelines indicate the operational framework on how each FAP shall support the participation of its researchers/participants within projects funded under Horizon 2020
- In practice, the Guidelines can be considered like a parallel call for the submission of research and innovation proposals in coordination with Horizon 2020
- Each FAP can adjust them to their own needs, funding capacities, research & innovation priorities, funding lines



1. Available local programs/funds that could provide support to Brazilian Horizon 2020 participants

Horizon 2020 is open to participation from across the world. European researchers can include partners from any other countries when preparing H2020 proposals. This means that Brazilian researchers, enterprises and institutions can team up with European partners to develop together knowledge, research data and leading scientific teams and networks.

Not all international partners are automatically eligible for funding by Horizon 2020. While the European Union will fund the participation of partners from developing countries, it does not automatically fund the partners from industrialised countries such as Brazil.

Brazilian participants themselves determine the sources of funding and resources for their part of the project: these may be own funds of the participating institutions, as well as funds received from Brazilian ministries, foundations and other research organisations in Brazil. Contributions can also be made in kind.

Potential Brazilian participants are therefore always encouraged to contact relevant research and innovation funding bodies and organisations such as the State Foundation for Research Support (FAPS), National Research Council (CNPq), Ministry of Science Technology and Innovation (MCTI) to seek funding for their participation in Horizon 2020.

Existing local co-funding mechanisms in Brazil

Different funding schemes for allowing Brazilian researchers to take part into Horizon 2020 are being set up in different Brazilian states through the existing Research Foundations in each Brazilian State. The first scheme was established by the Research Foundation of the State of São Paulo (FAPESP) in 2015. Following this, the National Council of Research Foundations (CONFAP, which previously signed an agreement with the EU Delegation to Brazil) has led a coordinated effort among the other research foundations in Brazilian States to follow the example of FAPESP. As a result, co-funding schemes for Brazilian researchers are available in the following states:

Available local support for H2020 participants from non-EU countries

- Countries with jointly agreed co-funding mechanism covering most or all thematic areas: [China, Hong Kong & Macao, Republic of Korea, Mexico, Russia, Taiwan](#)
- Countries with jointly agreed co-funding mechanism covering selected thematic areas: [Australia, India, Japan](#)

➤ **Openness:** the Guidelines should open to all Priorities and Calls to be launched within Horizon

- Excellent Science
- Industrial Leadership
- Societal Challenges

➤ **Evaluation:** depending on the need of each FAP, the evaluation can be either done only within H2020 or also by the FAP respectively involved: each FAP chooses what is best

- Projects positively evaluated by the FAP shall be only approved if also approved under H2020
- Proponents shall have to attach to their proposal sent to the FAP also the complete proposal submitted under H2020 in order to allow a global assessment
- Confidentiality is guaranteed
