- ✓ Main areas for cooperation: marine research, bioeconomy: agriculture, health, renewable energy: advanced biofuels, nanotechnology, ICT, innovation,

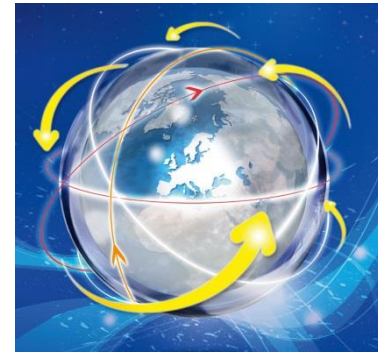

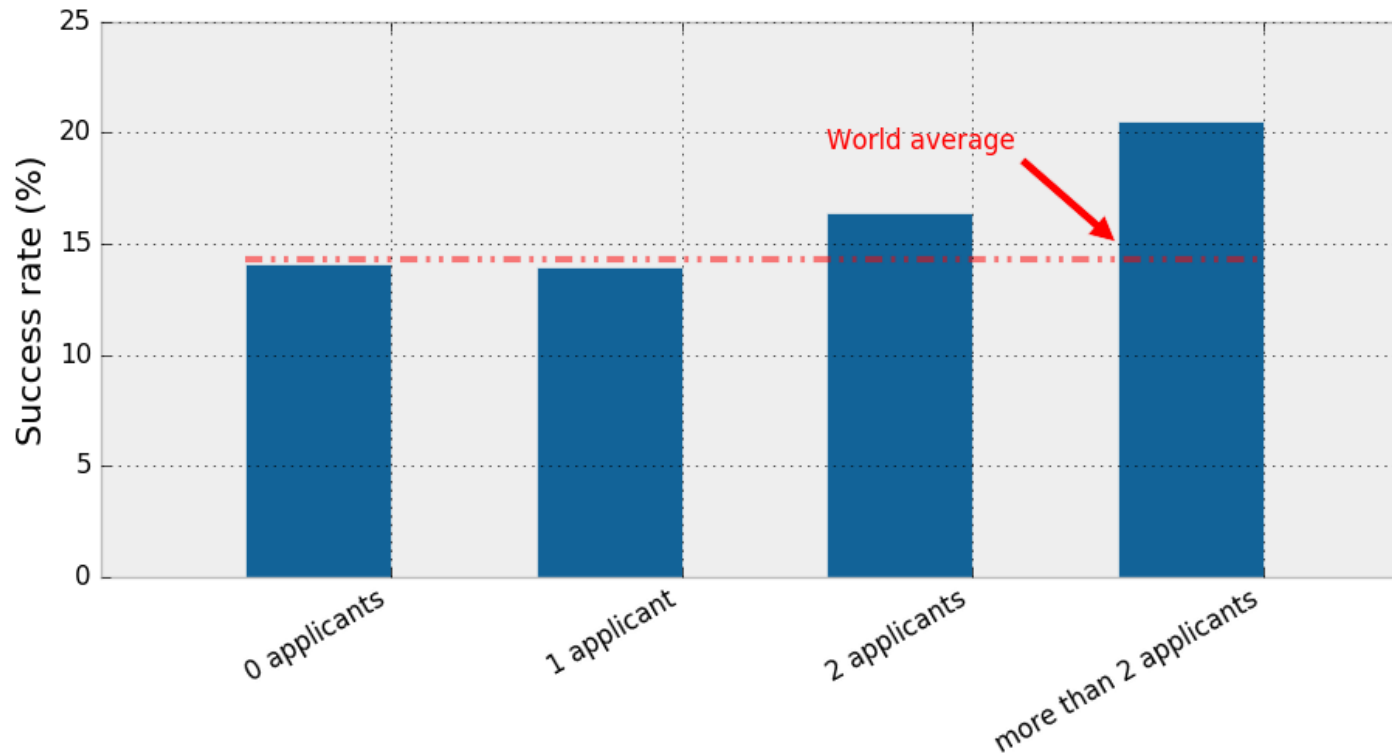

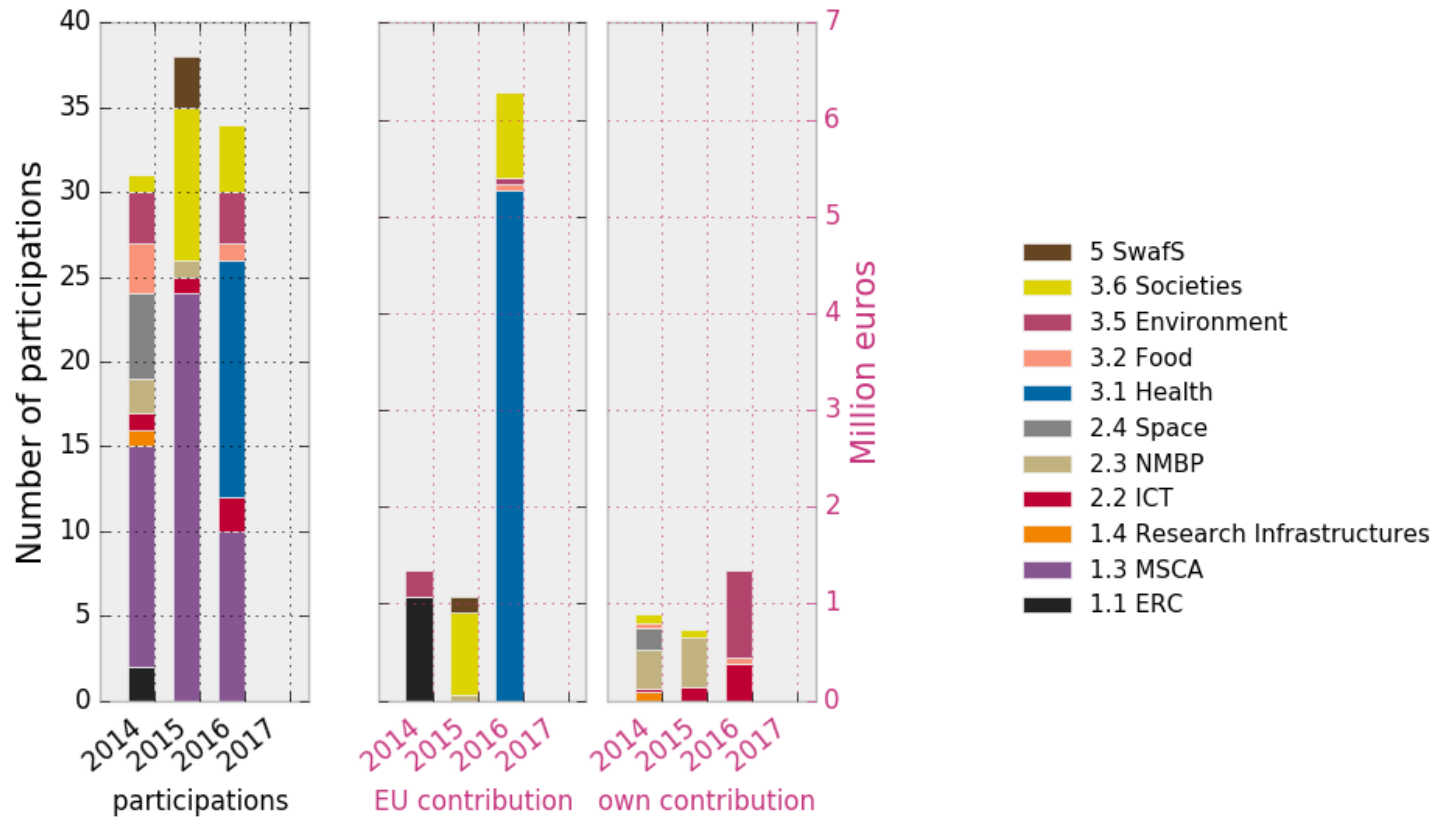


Success rates of proposals with different numbers of applicants from non-associated countries



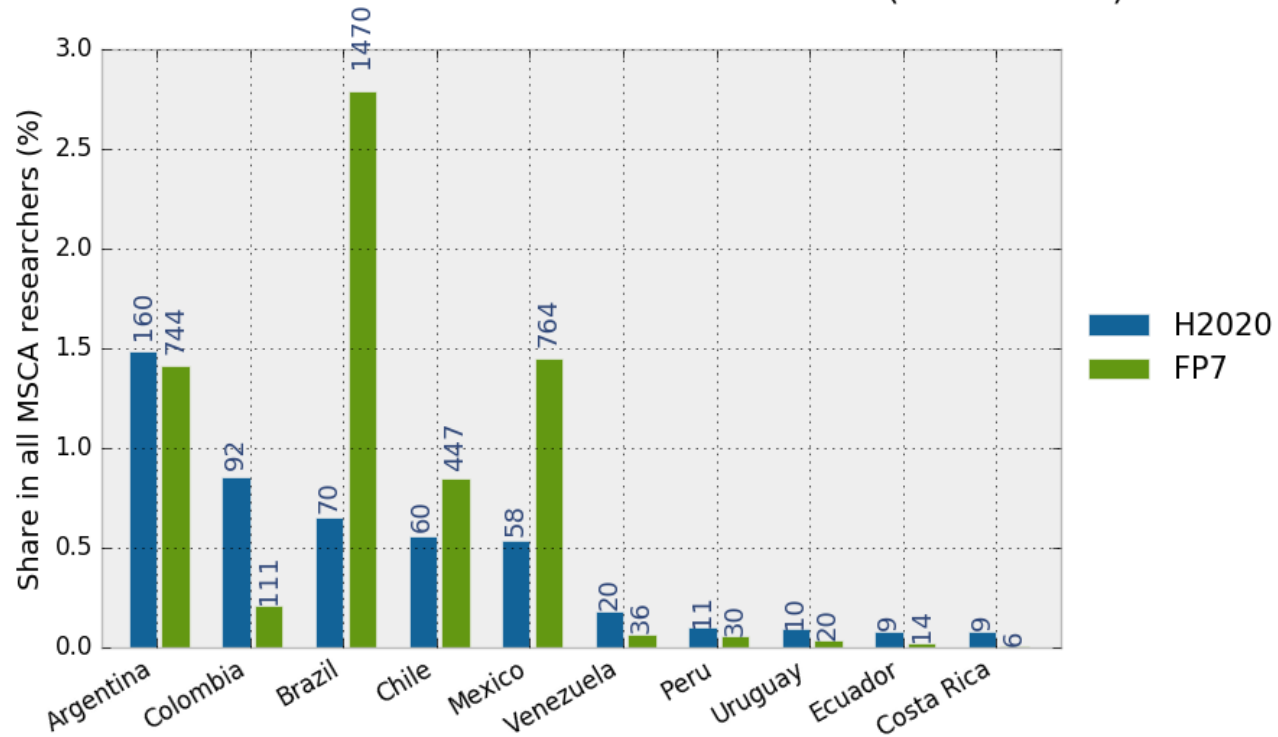

MSCA funded researchers from CELAC countries (nationalities)

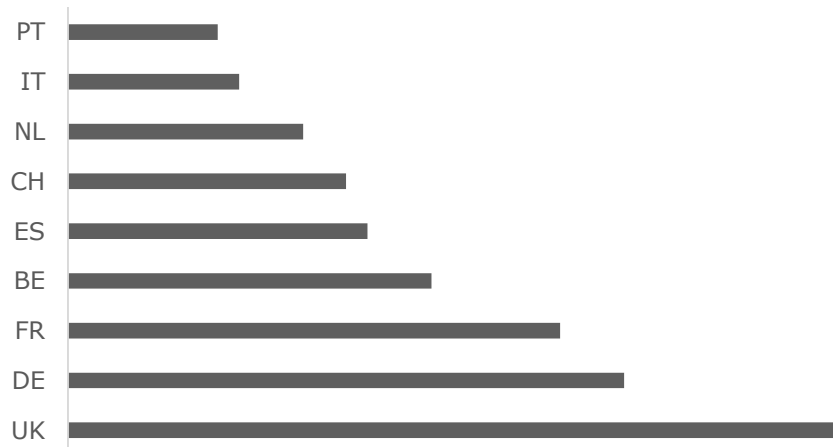

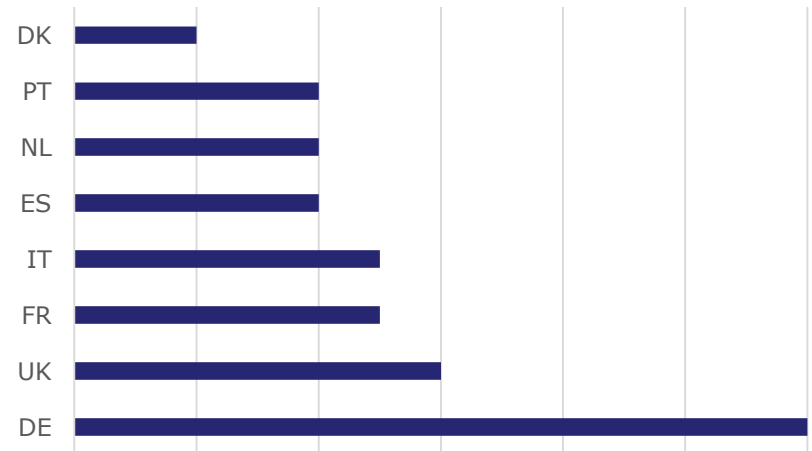

Brazilian fellows grouped by country of destination

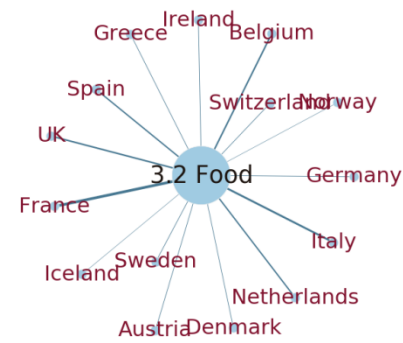
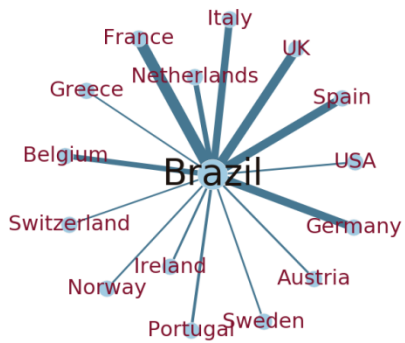
