- Coordination of research and innovation (R&I) funding programmes

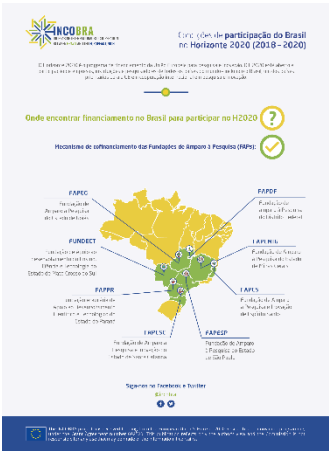

Hi all,

1. A main bottleneck for participation of Brazilian partners to European projects is the amount of funding that can be obtained. There are agreements between the EC and some of the foundations that support scientific research in the Brazilian states (for instance Fundação Araucária in Paraná) to fund projects involving Brazilian participants, which in case of success should be funded by the respective foundations. However, the problem is that in that case the Brazilian partner would never get a funding rate comparable to what can be obtained by the EC.

2. Are UK researchers eligible for these calls? How does the UK play out as a partner in the call considering BREXIT?

3. I would like to know if basic research could be acceptable in the call about Translation cancer call ? Could you explain more about this topic ?

4. Sorry, it is not clear how Fiocruz will be involved ... Will you oversee all the projects? How do we get the funding if successful? Through FAPESC in Santa Catarina, for instance? Or through FIOCRUZ?
